This new chapter is being established because of the growing number of poorer, underserved populations of people that are suffering from diabetes.

Consider this:

- One in 10 Minnesotans either have diabetes or are at high risk of developing it
- 281,000 Minnesotans have diabetes; of that total, 200,000 know they have diabetes and 81,000 do not know that they have diabetes.
- 232,000 Minnesotans have impaired fasting glucose (IFG), a form of pre-diabetes.
