

Lions Clubs International Foundation (LCIF) funding is provided in the form of grants to Lions districts in support of Lions projects.

These grants aid Lions worldwide in humanitarian efforts too large for individual clubs or districts to fund alone.

One hundred percent of every dollar donated to the Foundation goes directly to a project. Since LCIF was funded in 1968, it has awarded more than 10,000 grants, totaling more than US\$700 million.

Through grants, LCIF and Lions are able to serve even more people in need around the world.

- **April 21, 2010:** Standard, Core 4 and IAG grant application deadline for review at the June 21, 2010 board meeting
- May 14, 2010: SightFirst grant application deadline for review at the August 2010 SightFirst Advisory Committee meeting
- **June 18, 2010:** Lions Quest grant application deadline for review at the August 2010 Lions Quest Advisory Committee meeting
- **June 18, 2010:** Standard, Core 4 and IAG grant application deadline for review at the August 19, 2010 board meeting
