Information Needed by Providers

- Benefit Determination (Part B, D or Commercial)
- Patient Eligibility
- Provider Reimbursement Amount
- Patient Financial Responsibility (Copay etc)

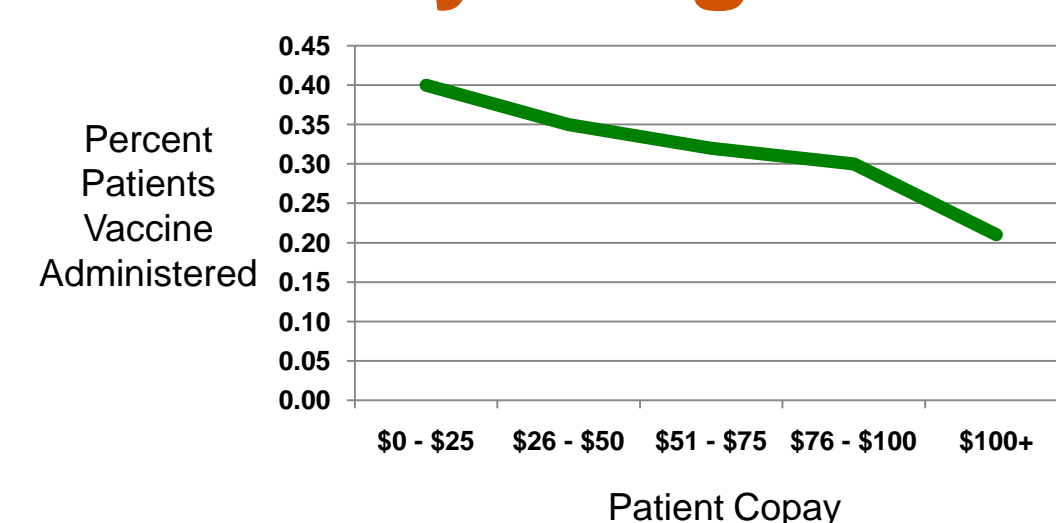
Without a means to efficiently obtain this information prior to administration providers are unwilling to actively purchase and administer vaccines, especially more expensive drugs.

System Issues Impeding Utilization

- Pharmacies** do not have systems to determine eligibility and submit **medical** claims for Influenza and other vaccines covered by **Part B** and other **Medical Insurance**
- Physicians** and other medical providers do not have systems to determine eligibility and submit **pharmacy** claims for Shingles and other vaccines covered by **Part D** and other **Pharmacy Insurance**

Patient \$ Responsibility Large Factor

Out of Pocket \$ is most significant factor in patient's decision whether to receive shingles vaccine



Provider Network and Clearinghouse Solution

Pharmacies

- Enroll in National Immunization Network for Part B and Commercial Payers
- Use their **existing pharmacy systems** to check eligibility, view patient copays and submit medical claims through TransactRx clearinghouse. *No additional software required.*

Medical Providers

- Enroll in Part D Network
- Use the TransactRx web portal to check eligibility, view patient copays, view provider reimbursement and submit pharmacy claims
- Payments from PBMs are processed through TransactRx and remitted to providers with standardized EOPs
