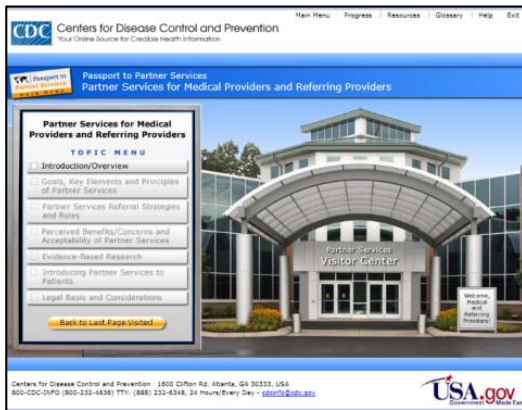
Offered by the National Disease Intervention Services Training Center (DISTC) in conjunction with the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC)

### I. For Medical/Referring Providers Who Refer Patients to Partner Services:

(Free CME, CHES, CNE credits available)

**Track A** - single online module

**Track B:** Partner Elicitation and/or Notification primarily for HIV

- 13 sequenced online modules
- Plus 3-day classroom training

**Track C:** Partner Elicitation and/or Notification and Referral for Gonorrhea, Chlamydia, HIV, and Syphilis (excluding case management and VCA)

- 13 sequenced online modules
- Plus 3-day classroom training

**Track D:** Partner Elicitation and/or Notification and Referral for All Diseases, including Syphilis Case Management and Visual Case Analysis (VCA).

- 14 sequenced online modules (Plus optional LOT system)
- Plus VCA-E3 webinar series
- Plus 5-day classroom training and the component

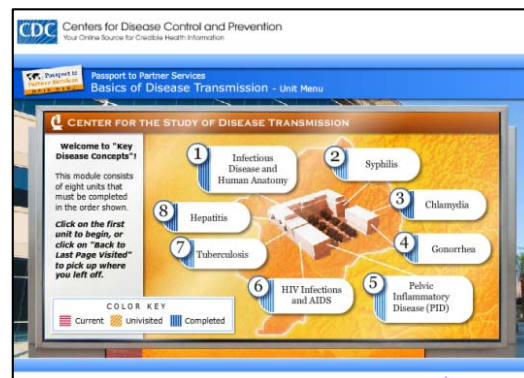
